A proof is a simulation of the final document's appearance before printing that shows final layout, color and text, which we use as a reference to print. Proofing is required to insure that your job prints the way you expect it to. Inspection and approval is the customer's responsibility.

We offer two types of proofing methods:

Digital Proofs

- Documents are e-mailed to customers in either JPEG or PDF formats.
- Large size documents are available for download in our secure FTP site.
- Color fidelity of both formats is affected by monitor calibration, lightning and the use of Pantone Color.
- Pantone color may not appear as true on your screen.

Paper Proofs

Proofing Microsoft jobs presents special challenges. Microsoft files cannot be used as graphic file and they are not usable printing. As a result, PDF, JPEG or Kodak proofs may not accurately predict printing results for these files.

Please convert your Microsoft files into PDF or use another graphic design software such as Photoshop, Illustrator, InDesign, etc. to create your files for printing.
